Also known as the Variegated Marblefish, this small fish is often seen darting upside-down amongst sponges and corals on the roof of caves and ledges on rocky reefs. It feeds on small shrimps, crabs and worms. It is recognised by its large triangular head and large eyes. It is the only member of an Antarctic fish family (the icefishes) that occurs in southern Australia.
