

Ringed Toadfish

This pufferfish is easily recognised by the dark narrow ring around the side (pectoral) fin. It has a longer more conical snout than the more common Smooth Toadfish. It occurs on seagrass and sand environments along the coast. Fused teeth form a small beak used to feed on small crustaceans and other invertebrates.
